THE ROUTE

India's Big Three large mammals across two of the country's greatest wildlife reserves



Thirteen days / twelve nights tracking India's iconic Big Three across Kaziranga and Ranthambore

DAY 1

Arrival in Delhi

Relax with VIP assistance at the airport and transfer to a luxury hotel to unwind from the international journey.

ARRIVAL

DAY 2

Flight to Assam & Transfer to Kaziranga

Board a morning flight to Guwahati. Private luxury transport for a 4-hour drive along the Brahmaputra River valley to Kaziranga. Check into a premium river lodge on the park boundary.

KAZIRANGA

DAY 3

Kaziranga — Day 1 Safaris

First of three full days of private safaris across Kaziranga's ranges. View the prehistoric-looking Greater One-Horned Rhinoceros moving through tall elephant grass, and look for massive Wild Water Buffalo at close range.

DAY 4

Kaziranga — Day 2 Safaris

Second intensive Kaziranga day extending into different range zones. Massive Wild Water Buffalo herds and wild Asian Elephants moving through the floodplain grasslands alongside Swamp Deer.

DAY 5

Kaziranga — Day 3 Safaris

Final Kaziranga morning — target the Bengal Tiger, apex predator of the park's vast landscape. Kaziranga has one of the highest tiger densities in India and consistently produces sightings across its different zones.

BENGAL TIGER

DAY 6

Return Flight to Delhi

Transfer back to Guwahati for a domestic flight to Delhi. Overnight in a luxury airport hotel to prepare for the drive south tomorrow.

TRANSIT

DAY 7

Drive to the Pink City of Jaipur

Drive 5 hours in comfort to Jaipur. Afternoon exploration of the grand Amber Fort — a taste of classic Rajput architecture and Indian history before entering tiger country.

AMBER FORT

DAY 8

Transit to Ranthambore Tiger Reserve

Short 3.5-hour private drive to Ranthambore, where ancient fortress ruins crumble directly into dry deciduous tiger forest. Check into an ultra-luxury safari camp on the reserve boundary.

RANTHAMBORE

DAY 9

Ranthambore — Day 1 Safaris

First of three full safari days across Ranthambore's lakes and valleys. The reserve is famous for its tigers' unusual comfort around ancient stone structures and lakeside settings — some of the most dramatic big cat photography in India.

BENGAL TIGER

DAY 10

Ranthambore — Day 2 Safaris

Second Ranthambore day — diversify target species to Sloth Bears foraging in rocky terrain and Leopards moving through the dense bamboo valleys that flank the main tiger zones.

DAY 11

Ranthambore — Day 3 Safaris

Final Ranthambore morning and afternoon safaris. Three full days of coverage across the park's zones gives an excellent cumulative sighting record of the reserve's territorial tigers.

DAY 12

Private Drive to the Taj Mahal — Agra

Drive 5 hours to Agra. Visit the magnificent Taj Mahal at sunset — one of the most photographed structures in the world, and a fitting counterpoint to the wild landscapes of the past ten days. Overnight in Agra.

DAY 13

Agra Fort & Return to Delhi for Departure

Morning visit to Agra Fort, followed by a 3-hour private drive via the express highway back to Delhi's IGI Airport for the late evening international flight home.
